Craig Carter had 59 cases
on the docket.

Jacob Kelley, 44, of Ava,
received three years in
the Department of Cor-
rections (DOC) for pos-
session of a controlled
substance.

Joshua Garrison, 44, of
St. Joseph, received four
years in the DOC for third
degree assault.

Coty Holloway, 34, of
Mountain Grove, received
four years in the DOC for
first degree stalking, a
first offense.

Jonathan Jaeger, 42, of
Mountain Grove, received
five years supervised pro-
bation for possession of a
controlled substance.

Rodney Trudeau III,
31, of Cabool, received
five years in the DOC for
unlawful possession of a
firearm and tampering
with a motor vehicle (first
offense).

Kevin Sartor, 51, of
Mountain Grove, re-
ceived 10 years in the

DOC for trafficking drugs
in first degree over the
statutory amount and
four years for keeping
or maintaining a public
nuisance.

There were probation
cases with a DOC sen-
tence.

ceived seven years in the
DOC; Rodney Trudeau
III, 31, of Cabool, received
five years in the DOC and

en years in the DOC for

four years in the DOC
