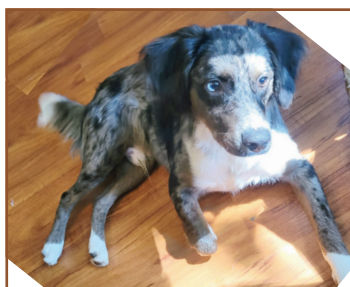

The position is non-exempt. The position is for the Salem area but may be based at any of the IECA locations dependent upon need at time of hiring and may be relocated at any time during employment.

The primary job duties will be building and repairing overhead and underground power distribution lines within the scope of his/her training and certification in a safe and efficient manner within accepted operations standards. Qualified applicants must be able to operate a bucket truck, digger, trencher, forklift and skid loader to frame and set poles. Must have journeyman knowledge of equipment and setting of poles, repairing and framing of poles. Ability to hook up single-phase and multi-phase transformer connections using the correct configuration to assure the end user of proper voltage levels is required. Qualified applicants will have experience in conducting tree trimming activities and tree maintenance duties.

Applicants are required to have a high school diploma or equivalent. Bucket Truck Operator shall have certification of completion of an approved electrical lineman program or applicable/comparable experience. A class A CDL license is required.
